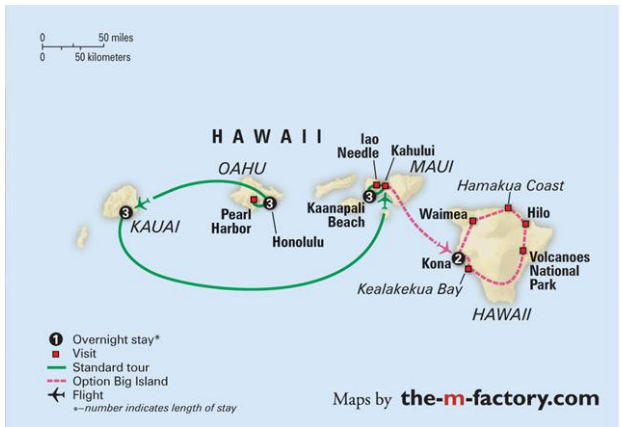

Day 1: Thursday, March 14, 2013

Arrive Honolulu, Oahu - Tour Begins

Day 2: Friday, March 15, 2013

Oahu

This morning, "Remember Pearl Harbor" as you embark on a historic journey from the site of the attack to the USS Missouri where the Japanese signed the surrender in 1945. Begin at the World War II Valor in the Pacific National Monument to view artifacts from the attack and a short documentary on the "Day of Infamy." Travel by naval launch to the white marble-clad USS Arizona Memorial. Next, explore the USS Missouri, the last battleship built by the U.S. Navy. The "Mighty Mo" served from World War II through Desert Storm. Your final stop is the Pacific Aviation Museum to see and learn about the aircraft involved in the attack during the war. After this poignant experience, take a city tour of Honolulu highlighting the historic Iolani Palace, the impressive state Capitol building, Kamehameha's statue, and the moving National Cemetery of the Pacific, known as the Punchbowl. *Today breakfast and dinner will be included.*

Day 3: Saturday, March 16, 2013

Oahu

Spend a full day at leisure in paradise. Explore Waikiki, relax by the pool or enjoy optional visits to world-famous surf spots and the Dole Plantation. This evening, enjoy a night of spectacular entertainment at the Society of Seven show, voted the "Best Show in Waikiki." Learn about sustainability practices and taste several of their coffees. *Today breakfast and dinner will be included.*

Day 7: Wednesday, March 20, 2013

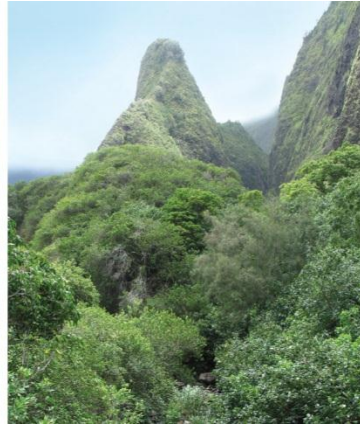
Kauai - Maui
