Day-by-Day Itinerary February 4 - 13, 2010

Day 1: Thursday, February 04, 2010

Arrive Honolulu, Oahu - Tour Begins

Aloha! Your tour of the sun-drenched Hawaiian Islands begins in Honolulu. Upon arrival you'll be greeted with a traditional Hawaiian floral lei and taken by limousine to your hotel.

Day 2: Friday, February 05, 2010

Oahu

This morning you depart on a historic journey from the site of the attack on Pearl Harbor to the signing of the Japanese surrender on the USS Missouri. Begin at the USS Arizona Visitors Center to view artifacts from the attack and a short documentary on the "Day of Infamy" before boarding your launch to cross Pearl Harbor to the USS Arizona Memorial. Next, explore the USS Missouri, the last battleship built by the US Navy, which served from World War II through Desert Storm. Your final stop is the Pacific Aviation Museum to see and learn about the many types of planes involved in the attack. After this poignant experience, take a city tour of Honolulu highlighting the historic Iolani Palace, the impressive state Capitol building, and the moving National Cemetery of the Pacific, known as the Punchbowl. *Today breakfast and dinner will be included.*

Day 3: Saturday, February 06, 2010

Oahu

Enjoy a full day at leisure in paradise. Take a walk on the beach or simply relax by your hotel's pool. **□This evening, enjoy a night of spectacular entertainment at the Society of Seven show, voted the "Best Show in Waikiki."**□ Offering a spirited mixture of dance, show tunes, Vegas thrills and pop hits, their high-energy performance is sure to put a smile on your face. *Today breakfast will be included.*

Day 4: Sunday, February 07, 2010

Oahu - Kauai

Later, visit Hawaii's largest coffee estate and learn about the coffee bean's journey from tree to cup. *Today breakfast will be included.*

Day 6: Tuesday, February 09, 2010

Kauai
