Day-by-Day Itinerary July 9 - 20, 2017

JULY 9: Depart Kansas City for our overnight flight to Edinburgh. Rosemary Stipe, Tour Manager, will meet you at the Airport and assist you throughout your tour.

JULY 10: Arrive Edinburgh Scotland. The group will be transferred to the first visit of our tour, the majestic Edinburgh Castle. We will then check into our hotel for the next three nights, located on the Royal Mile.

JULY 11: After our full Scottish breakfast we will depart for our included visit to Holyrood Palace. This afternoon we will drive into the Scottish countryside and enjoy a visit of Kingsbarns Distillery prior to our stop in St. Andrews where you will enjoy free time. This is the "home of Golf!" We will return home to the Royal Mile in Edinburgh.

JULY 12: After breakfast we will depart for our panoramic tour of Edinburgh. Afterwards, we will visit the Royal Yacht Britannia, the #1 visitor attraction in all of the UK. Enjoy your final night in Edinburgh.

JULY 13: After breakfast, we transfer to Waverley Station where we board our high speed train to London. Our first stop is one of the wonders of the world and the best known prehistoric monument in Europe dating back 5000 years, Stonehenge. JULY 16: After our included English breakfast, we will transfer to London Heathrow Airport for our flight to Dublin. Arrive Dublin and enjoy a panoramic tour of the city. We soon begin our drive along the stunningly beautiful Antrim Coast in Northern Ireland to our home for the evening. Our hotel is in a quiet village located right on the Irish Sea.

JULY 17: Enjoy your delicious full Irish breakfast prior to leaving for our first visit of the day, a UNESCO World Heritage site, the famous Giant's Causeway. 40,000 hexagon shaped basalt columns make up the landscape here. We then stop at the Medieval walled city of Derry where we will enjoy a walking tour hosted by a local guide. Our next two nights are spent in the #1 hotel in all of Ireland. The scenery here is stunning and the Hospitality unsurpassed!
