Day-by-Day Itinerary October 10 – 20, 2020

OCT. 10: Depart Kansas City for our overnight flight to Ireland.

OCT. 11: Arrive Dublin, Ireland to be met by Damien O'Reilly, our local driver and guide. Upon arrival we will show you a bit of Dublin on a panoramic tour before we start our journey North along the profoundly stunning Antrim coast. Our home for this evening is located in a sleepy village right on the Irish Sea. Enjoy your first night in Ballygally Castle Hotel.

Scheduled hotel - Ballygally Castle Hotel or similar (B)

OCT. 12: After a full Irish breakfast, we have a special day in store for you. We begin the day with a spectacular visit to the Giant's Causeway, Ireland's UNESCO World Heritage site, where you will view 40,000 hexagon shaped basalt columns. This afternoon we include a guided tour of the medieval walled city of Derry with our own local guide before driving to our home for the next two nights, the acclaimed Harvey's Point.

Scheduled hotel - Harvey's Point Hotel or similar (B)

OCT. 13: Harvey's Point is known for their fabulous breakfasts in the Lakeshore Restaurant. After this experience some of you may not want to leave the hotel, but we have a wonderful day in store for you. Damien will show you the spectacular beauty of Donegal as we tour the county. We will end our day in Ardara where you will enjoy a tweed weaving demonstration of world renowned Donegal tweed.

Scheduled hotel - Harvey's Point Hotel or similar (B)

OCT. 14: After our full Irish breakfast, we begin our journey through the West of Ireland to County Mayo. We will stop at Belleek China Factory for an included tour this morning. Our next stop is W.B. Yeats's grave at Drumcliffe. Yeats was awarded the Nobel Prize for Literature in 1923. After our visit we proceed to our home for the next two nights in Westport, County Mayo. Matt Molloy's pub is famous for traditional music there.

Scheduled hotel - Knockranny House Hotel or similar (B)

OCT. 15: Enjoy your delicious breakfast prior to our tour today. Our travels take us to Achill Island, the largest island off the Western coast of Ireland. Early human settlements on Achill date to 3000 B.C. Achill was home to the O'Malley clan and the famous Pirate Queen, Grace O'Malley. The Atlantic coastal drive here is spectacular. We return home to an included dinner at our hotel this evening.

Scheduled hotel - Knockranny House Hotel or similar (B, D)

OCT. 16: After our Irish breakfast, we will drive along the Western coast of Ireland, which has inspired poets and painters alike. We will enjoy a panoramic tour of Galway City prior to our visit this afternoon to the majestic Cliffs of Moher, 700 foot high cliffs bordering the Atlantic Ocean. Our home for the evening is just directly across the road from Bunratty Castle and Durty Nelly's pub! Enjoy your stay in Bunratty village.

Scheduled hotel - Bunratty Castle Hotel or similar (B)



OCT. 17, 18: After our included breakfast, we will give you some free time this morning to enjoy an OPTIONAL visit to Bunratty Castle and Folk Park or take time to shop in Blarney Woollen Mills. We will then continue on to our home for the next two nights in Killarney, known as "Heaven's Reflex." On Oct. 18, you can take an OPTIONAL jaunting car ride from the hotel. We will then show you the Dingle Peninsula, one of the most beautiful coastal drives in the world according to National Geographic. You will have some free time in Dingle prior to returning to Killarney.

Scheduled hotel - Randles Hotel or similar (B) two nights

OCT. 19: After breakfast, we travel to Dublin, the capital city of the Republic of Ireland. We will take you on a panoramic tour and then give you time for shopping for those last minute purchases. Rosemary will accompany anyone wishing to visit the Book of Kells at Trinity College (OPTIONAL). Enjoy your last night in Ireland. Your hotel is located in Trim, County Meath, and is directly across from Trim Castle which was used while filming "Braveheart."

OCT. 20: It's time to bid farewell to Damien O'Reilly as he transfers us back to Dublin airport. We hope that you will carry some special memories home with you from your trip to the Emerald Isle and the 16th Annual Irish Treasures Tour. It's an honor to travel with you.
