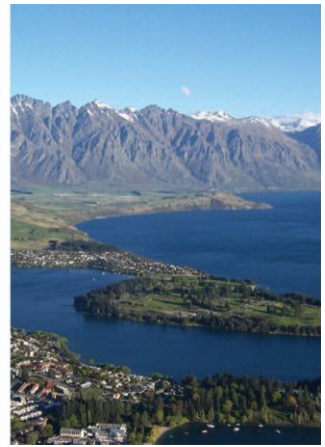

Day 1 – 2: February 3 – 4, 2014 Depart From Home Today you board your flight and begin the adventure of a lifetime. Crossing the International Dateline, you skip a day ahead.

Day 3: Wednesday, February 5, 2014 Arrive Cairns, Australia - Tour Begins Your tour begins today in Cairns, the gateway to the Great Barrier Reef. Don't forget to look up at the Southern Hemisphere's stars this evening after you join your mates for a welcome dinner. (D)

Day 4: Thursday, February 6, 2014 Cairns Today visit the Tjapukai Aboriginal Cultural Center. Day 5: Friday, February 7, 2014 Great Barrier Reef Board a high speed catamaran for an exciting excursion to the Great Barrier Reef. This is an immense series of 2,800 coral reefs which are home to amazingly diverse marine life. From your base on Green Island, you are able to explore the reef in many ways. In the tribal encampment area, the most interactive area of the park, you can interact with Tjapukai people as they teach you the art of throwing a boomerang or playing a didgeridoo. After watching a short demonstration on bush food and medicine, you can even taste their edible samples!
